WAIVER OF RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY

I have been advised by a judge of this court of the nature of the charges in the cases pending against me and the potential punishment for the offenses, which includes imprisonment in the penitentiary or confinement in jail. I understand the nature of these charges and the potential punishment for them if I am found to be guilty.

I have also been advised by a judge of this court that I have a right to a trial by jury or by a judge without a jury in this (these) case(s). The jury would have to unanimously agree before I could be found guilty. If the jury finds that I am guilty, the jury would also fix punishment in this case.

I understand that I may waive (give up) my right to a trial by jury.
